H.E. Ban Ki-Moon, the former Secretary General of the United Nations, challenged world leaders to commit to anti-poverty, environment and gender

justice targets with the Millennium Development Goals (MGDs). He also helped to create UN Women, the New Horizons peacekeeping initiative, and the Responsibility to Protect doctrine.

Dr. Kiran Mazumdar Shaw is a healthcare visionary, and a passionate philanthropist. Her impact as the Executive Chairperson of Biocon has made her an international role model to women in STEM. She is committed to equitable access to healthcare through affordable innovation, and positively impacted billions of lives during the pandemic.

Dr. Mitzi Perdue is a passionate advocate against human trafficking, and for landmine clearance. She has made three trips to Ukraine to highlight these issues, and is supporting the creation of shelters to protect women in danger of being trafficked. Savitri Devi (left) has helped several villages in the Koderma district of Jharkhand become water secure. Her village was experiencing extreme heat and drought when the Savera Foundation and Asia Initiatives trained people in watershed management. Savitri excelled during the training, and went on to lead her community to create rainwater channels and other water-collecting structures.

Manisha Upadhyay (right) from Azmabad village has been working with our local partner Mera Gaon Meri Dunia alongside teachers to increase student retention and success in village schools. She has also helped increase parental

involvement from nil to an impressive 75%. Through the youth groups she has helped create, she challenges existing social norms that keep girls from educational and career aspirations.
