Prof. M.S. Swaminathan, the world renowned agriculture scientist and humanist also known as Modern Gandhi and the Father of the Green/Evergreen Revolution in India, passed away on September 28, 2023. His words that all development should be Pro-poor, Pro-environment and Pro-Women have guided us since our founding in 1999. Recipient of the first World Food Prize and 84 honorary doctorates from around the world, he joined us every year, first in Tokyo, and then in New York, to confer the Swaminathan Award at our Galas as long as his health permitted. ### **SoCCs Enhance Education in Schools in Bihar**





In the heart of Gaya, Bihar, where Buddha is said to have attained enlightenment, Asia Initiatives is collaborating with 11 public schools with our Cascades of Learning program. Middle school students mentor and support younger students to to enhance overall academic success, forging a bond that extends far beyond the classroom. The SoCCs (Social Capital Credits) they earn for mentoring are redeemed for lessons in digital upskilling and coding.

# Young Leaders Pledge Their Prize Money to Their Communities
