Dear Friends,

Asia Initiatives program director Surabhi Prabhu and senior technology manager Gowrish Ramesh are currently visiting our projects in India, and getting inspired!







Their first stop is **Gaya**, where Buddha attained enlightenment. With our local partner **Karunodaya**, we are working in 14 Government schools in underserved areas, establishing computer labs and our **Cascade of Learning** program. Children earn SoCCs by mentoring younger children and helping them with homework, etc. While only 35% of students could read at grade level

at the start of the program, 72% can do so at the end of our first year. Mentors have also been enlisted to help with conducting the morning assembly in their respective schools, helping students build confidence and leadership skills. Students redeem the SoCCs earned for attending digital literacy classes. The great interest and enthusiasm for learning digital literacy skills has resulted in substantial increase in school enrollment and attendance.
